The Green Carnival is a step forward for Nee Soon as we continue to work towards a greener and sustainable town.

Informative booths, engaging workshops, and enlightening talks organised by grassroots leaders, schools, government agencies, and community groups served as great resources for residents to understand how they can be part of this green movement.

Hands-on workshops gave residents the chance to upcycle soft drink cans and old clothes. Residents also learnt ways to integrate small eco-friendly habits such as proper recycling methods, waste reduction strategies, and hydroponic farming into their daily lives at the interactive booths.

Ongoing green and sustainable programmes such as Kayak and Klean, monthly recycling drives, and SHWAP (Shop and Swap) for Sustainability were also featured at the carnival.

A highlight of the carnival was a fashion showcase by students from Raffles Design Institute, casting a spotlight on sustainable fashion and the creativity and talents of these students. As a means to prolong the life of fabrics, these students took clothes such as denim jeans, shirts, and even bed linens donated by residents and turned them into new chic clothes.

As the event concluded, residents left with practical knowledge and resources to actively contribute towards a greener Nee Soon and Singapore. Nee Soon Green Carnival was a successful event, showing off Nee Soon’s commitment to nurturing our green home with a heart.

YOUTHS ADD FINAL TOUCHES ON SUSTAINABILITY WALL MURAL

On 24 August 2023, four staff members of Tzu Chi Humanistic Youth Centre (HYC) gathered at Blk 627 Yishun St 61 to add the final touches on one of the ten sustainability wall murals in Nee Soon — their own sustainability mottos.

As part of their recent initiative to inspire and remind residents to take climate action in their daily lives, Nee Soon Town Council (NSTC) has commissioned a local artist to paint unique sustainability messages on wall murals. These murals serve as backdrops for community benches made from upcycled decommissioned MRT seats.

Tzu Chi HYC is the youth arm of Tzu Chi, and has been a longstanding community partner in Nee Soon. The HYC mission is to inspire and empower young generations to create positive social impact, such as promoting climate action and sustainability. This collaboration with Tzu Chi HYC reflects NSTC's belief that community partners have an important and unique role to play in our climate efforts as a town. It is when we all come together that our efforts are multiplied.

Tzu Chi HYC staff carefully considered the sustainability mottos they were going to paint on the mural. They eventually decided on three key messages which resonated with them the most: "Don't think big, everything starts small", "B.Y.O" (which stands for "Bring Your Own") and "Human change, not climate change". They hope these messages will inspire action and ignite a sense of responsibility in the community.

RESOLVING WATER SEEPAGE CHALLENGES

"Water seepage is very frustrating for our residents. It is also a very complex problem, with many possible root causes, such as the age of the affected blocks, external wall condition, embedded pipes by home owners, air conditioning insulation deterioration, and hairline cracks, etc. These can make diagnosis of complex cases difficult and tedious to solve, and a long process may be needed to locate the source of these leaks," commented Ms Carrie Tan, Vice-Chairperson of Nee Soon Town Council (NSTC), during a visit to flats with recurrent water seepage issues earlier this year.

To highlight the urgency of the seepage issue, she invited Ms Sim Ann, Senior Minister of State for National Development, colleagues from the Housing and Development Board, Town Council staff and the appointed waterproofing contractors to join her in these visits.

Ms Carrie Tan also added that "inspection and rectification works are subject to weather conditions", which can extend the time needed to fix the issue.

Nee Soon Town Council is glad to share that there has been a significant reduction in the number of seepage cases in Nee Soon GRC. Since January 2023, the Town Council has managed to rectify a total of 537 cases bringing the number of outstanding cases to 79 cases in end August 2023. This is a sharp drop of 85% within eight months.

Seepage issues are unavoidable, especially in areas with older blocks. This issue is often exacerbated by incessant rain as the external walls of the blocks are exposed to prolonged pelting of the rain."

A task force was set up by the Town Council to demonstrate our commitment to resolve the seepage issues. In addition to having regular meetings with agencies and contractors to get updates on the progress of the rectification works, the Town Council also hired extra contractors to attend to the water seepage cases.

The multi-agency collaboration, led by the task force, has proven to be effective with a drop in outstanding water seepage cases. Seepage cases are ongoing as new cases will add up due to the rainy weather. The task force will continue to keep its foot on the pedal to keep the outstanding cases to a minimum.

UPCOMING UPGRADES UNITE NEE SOON RESIDENTS

Mrs Siti’s sentiments seemed to be shared by over a hundred residents at the Nee Soon East Neighbourhood Renewal Programme (NRP) Consensus Gathering held on 23 September 2023. The gathering showcased proposed upgrades from Blks 227 to 235 Yishun St 21.

Launched in 2007, the NRP focuses on block and precinct improvements and is fully funded by the government. It aims to create vibrancy and synergy among amenities, reinvigorate spaces through greenery, and establish a secure and inclusive environment where everyone can live, work, and play comfortably. The NRP can only proceed if more than 75% support is obtained.

During the gathering, residents had the opportunity to view 3D renderings of the upgrades and vote for the ones they were most excited for. The playgrounds appeared to be the most popular, especially among families.

Mr Terence Kung, 56, said, “I usually bring my children to the playground at Northpoint, so it’s good that there will be an upgraded playground closer to me.”

MP for Nee Soon GRC Mr Louis Ng enthused, “We’re excited that residents are joining in on this journey and coming together to make sure that Nee Soon remains our Home with a Heart!”

邻里更新计划(NRP) 于 2007 年启动，重点是街区和区域的改善，由政府全额出资。其目的是在各种设施之间创造活力和协同效益，通过绿化为空间注入新的活力，并建立一个安全、包容的环境，让每个人都能舒适地生活、工作和娱乐。只有获得至少 75% 的支持，邻里更新计划才能继续进行。

GOING GREEN FOR THE COMMUNITY

USAHA HIJAU UNTUK MASYARAKAT



“There is only one earth. If you don't save it, no one else will.”

Caring for the community means caring for the environment we live in. Mr Ng Hak Hai, 62, holds this value close to his heart, and it is most evident in his actions. As the green champion for Nee Soon South and Chairman of the Nee Soon Clean and Green Committee since its establishment in 2011, he has spearheaded initiatives related to cleanliness, recycling, and a smoke-free environment in the community.

“It helps with the environment, and we have so much fun together,” Mr Ng said simply.

H.A.B.IT (Hold on And Bin IT) @ Nee Soon South, launched in October 2012, is one of Mr Ng's earliest and most cherished endeavours, so much so that he is fondly known as Mr HABIT. The anti-littering programme consisted of monthly litter-picking activities and raising awareness of shared responsibility in keeping the neighbourhood clean and green. What started as a small-scale project within the estate grew to over 200 dedicated participants within the same year.

He shares, “The first year we started, we collected nearly 1,500 kg of rubbish. But by 2019, it had gone down to only 200 kg. Many residents noted that their residences have become cleaner.”

Although the pandemic halted many such activities, Mr Ng continued to engage the community through online programmes. The adversity gave him and his team the opportunity “to regroup and see how we can go towards organic growth and more ground-up initiatives for our clean and green efforts”. While various programmes can be developed to engage a wider audience and attract more volunteers, he stressed that they must remain impactful. “It is a balance,” he emphasises.

Another of Mr Ng's achievements that has made a lasting impact in the community is the implementation of Designated Smoking Points (DSPs) to minimise secondhand smoke in public spaces. Initially, Mr Ng and his fellow resident volunteers patrolled the area to encourage smokers to use the DSPs. Later, they partnered with Khoo Teck Puat Hospital to educate smokers about early smoking-related health hazards by putting up posters in the DSPs. Since 2017, 50 DSPs have been introduced across 147 blocks in Nee Soon South.

Mr Ng's efforts have earned his constituency several awards. Most notably, Nee Soon South was the first constituency to receive the ASEAN Environmentally Sustainable Cities Award. Yet, he finds the greatest reward in residents' appreciation and the community they have built. He stresses, “Community work is solely based on the people, our volunteers.”

Amidst large-scale sustainability projects, Mr Ng underscores the importance of simple, everyday actions. “For example, everyone could pledge ‘I will clean up after myself’, and that would be good enough. If everyone does that, the whole place will be clean.” He continues, “There is only one earth. If you don't save it, no one else will.”

Menyayangi masyarakat bererti menyayangi persekitaran tempat tinggal kita. Encik Ng Hak Hai, 62, berpegang erat kepada nilai ini dalam jiwanya, dan dibuktikan menerusi pelbagai usaha yang dilakukannya. Sebagai pejuang hijau bagi kawasan Nee Soon South dan Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Hijau dan Bersih Nee Soon sejak penubuhannya pada 2011, beliau telah menerajui pelbagai inisiatif yang berkaitan dengan kebersihan, kitar semula dan kawasan bebas asap rokok dalam masyarakat kita.

“Usaha-usaha ini membantu memelihara persekitaran dan kami seronok melakukannya bersama-sama,” kata Encik Ng.

Program H.A.B.IT (Hold on And Bin IT) di Nee Soon South yang dilancarkan pada Oktober 2012, merupakan salah satu usaha terawal Encik Ng dan paling dekat dengan hatinya, sehingga beliau lebih dikenali sebagai Encik HABIT. Program anti membuang sampah sembarangan ini merangkumi kegiatan mengutip sampah setiap bulan dan usaha meningkatkan kesedaran tanggungjawab bersama dalam menjaga kebersihan dan kehijauan kawasan kejiranan. Program yang bermula sebagai projek berskala kecil dalam lingkungan estet telah berkembang sehingga mempunyai lebih daripada 200 peserta berdedikasi pada tahun yang sama.

Beliau berkongsi, “Pada tahun pertama program ini dimulakan, kami telah mengumpulkan hampir 1500 kg sampah. Menjelang tahun 2019, jumlah kutipan sampah telah menurun sehingga hanya 200 kg. Ramai penduduk menyatakan bahawa kediaman mereka telah menjadi semakin bersih.”

Walaupun pandemik telah menghentikan banyak aktiviti sedemikian, Encik Ng memastikan penglibatan masyarakat berterusan melalui program dalam talian. Kesukaran tersebut telah memberi peluang kepada beliau dan pasukannya “untuk menyusun semula cara untuk meningkatkan pertumbuhan organik dan inisiatif akar umbi terhadap usaha bersih dan hijau”. Walaupun pelbagai program boleh dibangunkan untuk melibatkan golongan masyarakat yang lebih luas serta menarik

lebih ramai sukarelawan, beliau menekankan bahawa ia seharusnya kekal berkesan. “Keseimbangan adalah penting,” tegas beliau.

Satu lagi pencapaian Encik Ng yang telah memberi kesan yang berkekalan dalam masyarakat ialah pelaksanaan tempat merokok khusus (Designated Smoking Points atau DSP) untuk mengurangkan asap rokok terpakai di ruang awam. Pada mulanya, Encik Ng dan rakan sukarelawan masyarakat membuat rondaan di kawasan kejiranan untuk menggalakkan perokok menggunakan DSP. Kemudian, mereka bekerjasama dengan Hospital Khoo Teck Puat untuk mendidik perokok

tentang kesan buruk terhadap kesihatan peringkat awal yang berkaitan dengan merokok dengan meletakkan poster di DSP. Sejak tahun 2017, 50 DSP telah disediakan di 147 blok di Nee Soon South.

Atas usaha beliau, kawasan undinya telah menerima beberapa anugerah. Terutama sekali, Nee Soon South merupakan kawasan undi pertama yang menerima Anugerah Bandar Kemampanan Sekitaran ASEAN. Namun

begitu, ganjaran yang paling bermakna bagi Encik Ng ialah penghargaan penduduk dan masyarakat yang telah mereka bina. Beliau menegaskan bahawa kerja kemasyarakatan adalah berasaskan masyarakat, khususnya para sukarelawan kita.

Walaupun pelbagai projek kemampanan berskala besar terus dilaksanakan, Encik Ng menekankan pentingnya mengamalkan tindakan harian yang mudah. “Contohnya, sekiranya semua orang boleh berjanji bahawa ‘Saya akan membersihkan tempat yang saya gunakan’, ini sudah cukup baik. Sekiranya semua orang berbuat demikian, seluruh kawasan akan menjadi bersih.” Beliau menyambung, “Hanya ada sebuah bumi. Jika anda tidak menyelamatkannya, tiada sesiapa lagi yang akan melakukannya.”

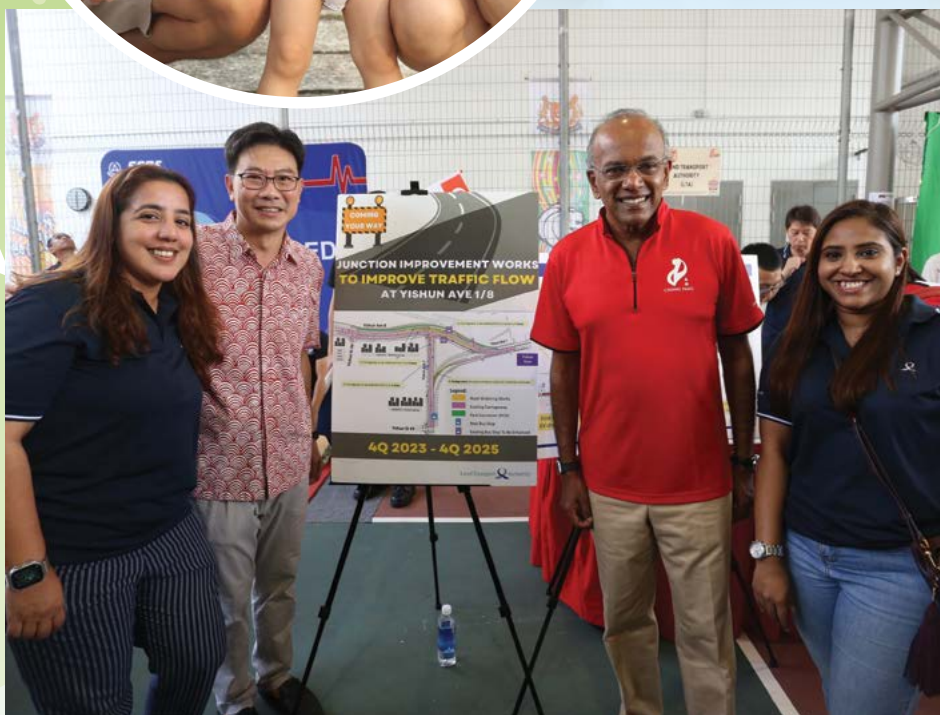

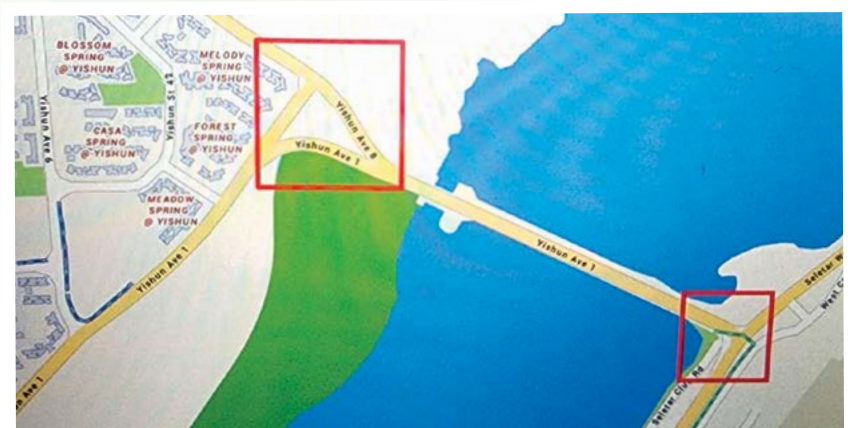

These are expected to start in Q4 of 2023. Some inconvenience should be expected when road works begin, but residents can look forward to significant improvements to the traffic situation.

These improvements are made possible by close collaboration and discussions between the Land Transport Authority (LTA) and Nee Soon Link grassroots leaders. Mr Goh and his grassroots leaders continue to work closely with LTA's engineering experts from the Commuter and Road Infrastructure Division.

Being a popular spot for scenery and jogging, residents will be delighted to hear that Mr Goh is also in talks with NParks to bring exciting improvements to the Yishun Dam Park Connector.

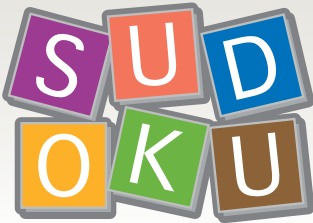

STUDY BUDDY: GOING BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

In the hustle and bustle of school and co-curricular activities, underprivileged students may get lost in the shuffle. They may be struggling with schoolwork while also trying to keep up a healthy social and home life. This is where CampusImpact's Study Buddy programme steps in, providing children aged seven to 14 with a safe and conducive place to study under the supervision of caring adult role models.

Started in 2006, CampusImpact is a social service agency located in Nee Soon that has been working to prepare the next generation by helping them develop positive attitudes, pioneering spirits and purposeful lives. Study Buddy, one of CampusImpact's after-school programmes, is more than just homework and study assistance — it provides a nurturing environment where children can thrive academically and personally.

Princeton, an 11-year-old student at Study Buddy, explained, "They give us freedom and let us use our imagination and creativity here. I even learned how to play Sudoku!"

Study Buddy organises events that help students stay active, physically and mentally. One such event is Wild Wednesday, a weekly event where students participate in outdoor sports such as basketball, football, and badminton. They are also brought on excursions to places like SAFRA Jurong, Pulau Ubin, and more.

At these events, children get the opportunity to meet volunteers from companies across various industries. At one of said events, the children had the opportunity to interact with air crew from Singapore Airlines. The air crew, who signed up as volunteers, spent a day with the children, sharing valuable insights about their profession followed by games — a great way for the children to learn valuable lessons through play.

"I've learned that teamwork helps us win a game," said 14-year-old student Sydney. "I've learnt about sportsmanship as well. I have to respect my opponents when I lose."

Study Buddy's ultimate aim is for each child who graduates from the programme to embody qualities such as respect, love, patience, and steadfastness, setting them on a path to a brighter future.

Ten-year-old Charleston beckoned more volunteers and students to join Study Buddy, "Please come to CampusImpact, it's really fun! Whether you are very active or if you prefer studying, you'll still learn a lot!"



学习伙伴：超越课堂

在繁忙的学校和课外活动中，弱势学生可能会在混乱中迷失方向。他们可能在学业上挣扎，同时也试图维持健康的社交和家庭生活。这就是CampusImpact的学习伙伴（“Study Buddy”）项目发挥作用的地方，为7至14岁的孩童提供一个安全和有益的学习环境，由富有爱心的成年榜样监督管理。

CampusImpact 成立于2006年，是位于义顺的社会服务机构，致力于帮助下一代培养积极态度、开创精神和有意义的生活，以备他们迎接未来。学习伙伴是CampusImpact 的课后项目之一，它不仅仅提供功课和学习帮助，也提供了一个培育孩子在学业和个人生活中茁壮成长的环境。

11岁的 Princeton 是学习伙伴的学生之一，他说：“他们给予我们自由，让我们在这里发挥想象力和创造力。我甚至学会了如何玩数独！”

学习伙伴组织帮助学生在身体和心理上保持活跃的活动。其中之一是“狂野星期三”，每周的户外体育活动，如篮球、足球和羽毛球。他们还参观了SAFRA Jurong、乌敏岛等地。

在这些活动中，孩子们有机会与来自各行各业的企业志愿者见面。在其中一个活动中，孩子们也有机会与新加坡航空的机组人员互动。这些机组人员报名成为志愿者，与孩子们一起度过一天，分享他们宝贵的专业见解，然后一起玩游戏——通过游戏让孩子们学习宝贵经验是一种绝佳方式。

14岁的学生 Sydney 说：“我学到了团队合作能帮助他们赢得比赛。我也学到了体育精神，即使输了，也得尊重我的对手。”

学习伙伴的最终目标是每个从该计划毕业的孩子都拥有尊重、爱心、耐心和坚韧等品格，为他们走向更光明的未来坦途。

10岁的 Charleston 呼吁更多志愿者和学生加入学习伙伴，“请来 CampusImpact，这里真的很有趣！无论你是非常活跃的人，还是喜欢学习的人，你都会学到很多！”

STUDY BUDDY: MELANGKAUI BATAS BILIK DARJAH

Dalam kesibukan kegiatan sekolah dan kokurikulum, sesetengah pelajar dari golongan kurang bernasib baik mungkin hilang arah. Mereka mungkin menghadapi masalah untuk menyiapkan kerja sekolah di samping cuba mengekalkan kehidupan sosial dan kediaman yang sihat. Oleh sebab itu, Program Study Buddy CampusImpact terlibat dalam menyediakan tempat yang selamat dan sesuai untuk pembelajaran kanak-kanak berumur tujuh hingga 14 tahun, di bawah pengawasan golongan dewasa suri teladan yang prihatin.

Dimulakan pada tahun 2006, CampusImpact merupakan sebuah agensi khidmat sosial yang terletak di Nee Soon. Agensi ini berusaha untuk memastikan generasi akan datang bersiap sedia dengan membantu mereka membangunkan sikap positif, semangat perintis dan hidup bermatlamat. Study Buddy, salah satu program selepas sekolah yang ditawarkan oleh CampusImpact, bukanlah sekadar membantu kanak-kanak belajar dan menyiapkan kerja sekolah. Program ini menyediakan persekitaran yang terpelihara bagi membolehkan kanak-kanak berkembang maju dari segi akademik dan peribadi.

Princeton, seorang pelajar dalam program Study Buddy yang berusia 11 tahun, menjelaskan, “Mereka memberikan kami kebebasan dalam menggunakan daya imaginasi dan kreativiti di sini. Saya juga belajar cara bermain Sudoku!”

Study Buddy menganjurkan pelbagai acara yang membantu para pelajar kekal aktif dari segi fizikal dan mental. Salah satu acara tersebut ialah Wild Wednesday, sebuah acara mingguan di mana pelajar mengambil bahagian dalam pelbagai jenis sukan luar seperti bola keranjang, bola sepak dan badminton. Mereka juga mengikut rombongan ke tempat-tempat seperti SAFRA Jurong, Pulau Ubin dan banyak lagi.

Dalam acara-acara ini, kanak-kanak juga berpeluang untuk bertemu dengan sukarelawan dari syarikat merentasi pelbagai industri. Dalam salah satu acara tersebut, mereka berpeluang untuk berinteraksi dengan kru kapal terbang dari Singapore Airlines. Kru kapal terbang yang mendaftar sebagai sukarelawan, meluangkan masa sehari bersama kanak-kanak tersebut, berkongsi pandangan berharga tentang profesi mereka yang kemudian disusuli dengan permainan — cara yang amat baik untuk kanak-kanak belajar melalui kegiatan bermain.

“Saya telah belajar bahawa semangat berpasukan dapat membantu kami memenangi sesuatu permainan,” kata Sydney yang berusia 14 tahun. “Saya juga belajar tentang sikap sukan. Saya perlu menghormati pihak lawan saya apabila saya kalah.”

Matlamat utama Study Buddy adalah untuk setiap kanak-kanak yang melengkapkan program ini dapat mewujudkan nilai-nilai seperti rasa hormat, kasih sayang, kesabaran dan ketabahan agar mereka berada di landasan menuju ke arah masa depan yang lebih cerah.

Charleston yang berusia 10 tahun memberikan isyarat agar lebih ramai sukarelawan dan pelajar menyertai Study Buddy, “Silalah datang ke CampusImpact — sungguh menyeronokkan! Terdapat banyak peluang pembelajaran tidak kira apa-apa saja minat anda!”

கல்வித்தோழன்: வகுப்பறைக்கும் அப்பால்

பள்ளி மற்றும் இணைக்கல்வி நடவடிக்கைகளின் வேகத்தில் வாய்ப்பு குறைந்த மாணவர்கள் பின்தள்ளப்படலாம். சமூக வாழ்க்கையோடு குடும்ப வாழ்க்கையையும் ஆரோக்கியமாக வாழ முயற்சி செய்யும்போது அவர்கள் பள்ளிப்படிப்பில் போராடிக்கொண்டிருக்கலாம். 7 முதல் 14 வயது வரையிலான குழந்தைகளுக்கு, அக்கறையுள்ள வயதுவந்த முன்மாதிரிகளின் மேற்பார்வையில் கேம்பஸ் இம்பேக்ட் திட்டம் பாதுகாப்பான மற்றும் உகந்த இடத்தை வழங்குகிறது.

2006 ஆம் ஆண்டில் தொடங்கப்பட்ட கேம்பஸ் இம்பேக்ட் (CampusImpact) திட்டம் என்பது நீ துனில் அமைந்துள்ள ஒரு சமூக சேவை நிறுவனம் ஆகும். நேர்மறையான அணுகுமுறைகள், புதுவழி காணும் மனம் மற்றும் அர்த்தமுள்ள வாழ்க்கையை வளர்க்க உதவுவதன் மூலம் இத்திட்டம் அவர்களைத் தயார்படுத்தும் வகையில் செயல்பட்டு வருகிறது. கேம்பஸ் இம்பேக்ட்டின் பள்ளிக்குப் பிந்தையத் திட்டங்களில் ஒன்றான கல்வித்தோழன், வீட்டுப்பாடம் மற்றும் கல்விஉதவி என்பதைவிட மேலான ஒன்று. இது குழந்தைகள் கல்வியில் மட்டுமின்றித் தனிப்பட்ட முறையிலும் செழித்தோங்க உதவும் ஒரு வளர்ப்புச் சூழலை வழங்குகிறது.

“அவர்கள் எங்களுக்குச் சுதந்திரம் தருகிறார்கள். மேலும் எங்கள் கற்பனைவளத்தையும் படைப்பாற்றலையும் இங்கு பயன்படுத்தவிடுகிறார்கள். நான் சுடோக்கு விளையாடக்கூடக் கற்றுக்கொண்டேன்!” என்று 11 வயது மாணவரான பிரின்ஸ்டன் விளக்கினார்.
